In 2011, Medical Marijuana of the Rockies decreased the trash they sent to the landfill. How did they do it?

They recycle and compost!

Medical Marijuana of the Rockies completed a waste audit through High Country Conservation Center and a lighting audit with Xcel Energy. They began composting tissue and other office scraps, through Summit County's pilot compost program. They continue to do so through Faction and Company, Summit County's private compost service. Composting has decreased the companies waste stream by 15%. They want to do more, but legislation governing medical marijuana disposal has so far made composting green scraps impossible.

Medical Marijuana of the Rockies also has a strong recycling program in place. This year they upgraded their recycle bins, ordering 35 liter bins in a mart design from simple human. Clearly labelled, easy to access bins are a simple way to make recycling easy for employees and customers.
