MIXED PAPER	Newspapers & Inserts; White & Light Colored Office Paper; Envelopes; Notebook Paper; Magazines; Phone Books <i>Staples, Paper Clips, Tape OK</i>	Neon Colored Paper; Tissues; Napkins; Paper Plates or Cups; Brown Paper Bags; Cardboard; Paperboard (Cereal Boxes); Plastic Bags
 PETE - CLEAR PLASTIC BOTTLES ONLY!	Soda bottles & water bottles labeled with a #1 only!	Plastic bags; Tubs; Styrofoam; Numbers #3 - #7 plastics of any kind!
 MILK JUGS & SOLID COLORED BOTTLES ONLY!	Milk jugs, detergent bottles, and shampoo bottles labeled with a #2 only!	Plastic bags; Tubs; Styrofoam; Numbers #3 - #7 plastics of any kind!
MIXED METAL CONTAINERS	Aluminum Cans; Aluminum Foil & Pie Plates; Tin Cans	Scrap Metal
CARDBOARD & PAPERBOARD	Cardboard; Paperboard (cereal boxes & six-pack containers); Brown Paper Bags. <i>Staples & Tape OK;</i> PLEASE FLATTEN	Milk or Soy Milk Cartons; Wax-Coated Cardboard; Other Paper
MIXED GLASS	Bottles & Jars; Clear, Yellow, Green, Blue Colors	CERAMIC DISHES, Window Glass; Drinking Glasses; Pyrex
BROWN GLASS	Bottles & Jars <i>Be a good sort – please separate your brown glass!</i>	CERAMIC DISHES, Window Glass; Drinking Glasses; Pyrex, other colors of glass
BATTERIES	<i>Please sort into marked bins:</i> Alkaline; Rechargeable (please tape terminals); Lithium Ion; Lead Acid Batteries (Auto, Marine, Computer Back-up Units)	Other Household Hazardous Waste
USED MOTOR OIL	Carefully pour into large container. <i>Any container that has had motor oil in it is NOT RECYCLABLE; please dispose of with household trash.</i>	Oil/water mix. Antifreeze or other fluids. <i>Motor oil containers are NOT RECYCLABLE; please dispose of with household trash.</i>
OIL FILTERS	Place in marked 55 gallon drums.	Other household hazardous waste.
ANTIFREEZE	Leave in sealed containers on top of motor oil bins.	Other household hazardous waste.
SCRAP METAL	<i>Available at the FRISCO & BRECKENRIDGE DROP-OFF CENTER ONLY.</i>	Appliances, propane tanks, fuel tanks, barbed wire, 55 gallon drums, batteries, computers or TVs.
