Acceptable Compost Items

Unlike home composting, all food scraps and non-recyclable paper products can be included in the compost drop off program.

Food Scraps

Fruit & veggies (pits and peels)
Meat, poultry, & seafood
Bones & fat trimmings
Dairy products
Processed foods
Bread and grains
Coffee grounds
Eggs and eggshells
Leftovers and spoiled food
Rice, beans, & pasta

Non Recyclable Paper Products

Coffee filters & tea bags
Paper towels, napkins, & facial tissue
Greasy pizza boxes
Uncoated paper plates & to-go boxes
Wax paper/cardboard
Tissue paper
Neon/fluorescent paper

Other

Please no

- * Plastic of any kind
- * Disposable soda or coffee cups (unless labeled compostable)
- * Plastic coated paper plates & cups
- * Pet waste
- * Frozen food boxes
- * Juice or milk type boxes with foil or plastic liner
- * Plastic bags, wrappers or film
- * Sugar & tea packets
- * Styrofoam
