Summit County Recycling Drop-off Center Locations:

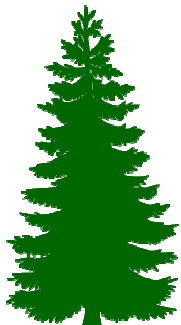
- Breckenridge—On County Road 450, near 7-Eleven
- Frisco—at the County Commons, next to the State Patrol building

Drop-off centers open 24 hours a day, seven days a week

BE A GOOD SORT—when in doubt, throw it out– RESPECT YOUR COMMUNITY PROGRAM!

In Silverthorne, Waste Management operates a drop-off center; call 888-964-9740 for information on hours and acceptable materials.

WRAPPING PAPER	non-metallic wrapping paper can be recycled in the MIXED PAPER bins at the drop-off centers. NO tissue paper or brown paper, please! <i>A greener solution: Use reusable gift bags and boxes or cloth</i>
CARDS & ENVELOPES	Cards & envelopes can be recycled in the MIXED PAPER bins at the drop-off centers. <i>A greener solution: Close the loop – choose recycled content</i>
CARDBOARD, GIFT BOXES, & BROWN PAPER	<i>Flattened</i> cardboard boxes, paperboard, gift boxes, and brown paper can be recycled in the CARDBOARD/ PAPERBOARD bins at the drop-off centers <i>A greener solution: Be respectful, please flatten boxes!</i>
STYROFOAM	NO STYROFOAM , of any kind, is accepted at any of the drop-off centers. Clean, dry packaging peanuts can be recycled at UPS Stores (Dillon 468-2800; Breckenridge 453-8080) <i>A greener solution: There is no solution. Sadly, its trash.</i>
PAPER PLATES, CUPS, & NAPKINS	NO PAPER PLATES or CUPS or NAPKINS can be recycled. Please throw them away. <i>A greener solution: Use reusables!</i>
OLD TVs, COMPUTERS, and OTHER THINGS	NO ELECTRONICS are accepted at drop-off centers, please bring them to the recycling facility at the landfill, open M-F, 7am-4pm. Fees apply, call 468-9263 for more info. <i>A greener solution: Take to proper facility—don't dump!</i>



CHRISTMAS TREE & WREATH RECYCLING:

- Breckenridge—710 Wellington Road, near the stables
- Frisco—At the Marina, in the lot to the right
- Silverthorne—Across from second Three Peaks entrance
- Summit County Landfill—Off Hwy 6, near Keystone
